Professor (Dr.) Kamal K. Misra, currently the Vice-Chancellor of the Utkal University of Culture, Bhubaneswar, was a Professor of Anthropology and Dean, School of Social Sciences at the Central University of Hyderabad. He was educated at Utkal University, Bhubaneswar; Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi; and University of Kent at Canterbury, UK. He has been teaching anthropology in various Universities in India and abroad since 1978. He was the recipient of the prestigious Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence Award in the USA and the Commonwealth Academic Staff Fellowship in the UK. He was also invited by the University of Bergen, Norway, as a Guest Researcher.

A Gold Medalist from Utkal University, he has a strong research interest in the areas of Culture, Environment and Development; Culture, Language and Cognition; Anthropological Theory; Cultural Symbols; Anthropology and Museums; and Anthropology of Gender. His regional interests include South Asia and South East Asia. He was honored with the Sarat Chandra Roy Memorial Medal by the Asiatic Society, Kolkata for his contribution to Anthropology.

Prof. Misra was the Director of National Museum of Mankind, Bhopal, and the Director of the Anthropological Survey of India, Kolkata, both under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India. He was appointed member of the High Level Committee constituted by the Prime Minister of India to prepare a status report on the Scheduled Tribes of India.

Prof. Misra was the Editor of *Humankind*, *Journal of Anthropological Survey of India*, and Associate Editor of *South-East Asian Perspectives*, *Manav*, etc. He is on the Editorial Advisory Board of *Anthropology Open Journal* (USA) *Indian Anthropologist*, *The Anthropologist*, *Journal of Ethnomedicine*, *The Oriental Anthropologist* and *The Scientific Journal International*. He has completed a large number of Research Projects and was a consultant of the UNDP for the project on Self-Governance in Tribal Areas of India. He had represented the Govt. of India at World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), Geneva, several times.

He has authored/edited/co-edited 23 books and published scores of research papers in journals of repute. His latest publications include *The Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups in India: Privileges and Predicaments* (Manohar, 2016), *Tribes and Analogous Peoples in India* (Gyan, 2015), *Dissent, Discrimination and Dispossession: Tribal Movements in India* (Manohar, 2014), *Gendering Material Culture: Representations and Practice* (Rawat, 2013), *Amazing Arunachal Pradesh: Land, People, Culture* (Aryan, 2013), *Cultural Pluralism: The Indian Scenario* (Gyan, 2012), *Displacement and Rehabilitation: Solutions for the Future* (Gyan, 2012), *Anthropological Impact Assessment of Development Initiatives* (INCAA, 2012), *Tribal Movements in India: Visions of K.S.Singh* (Manohar, 2012), *Plural Nature of Anthropology* (INCAA, 2012), etc. His books, *Recent Studies on Indian Women* (Rawat, 2007 and 2010 reprint), *Text Book of Anthropological Linguistics* (Concept, 2000), etc. have been popular as text books in many Universities in India and abroad.
