In pursuance of the letter No.HE-NSS-COMN-0033-2020/8082/HE dated 18.02.2020, No.27412/HE dated 25.8.2020 and Consequent upon the decision taken in the State Level Advisory Committee Meeting for NSS held on 5.11.2019, the enhanced existing social service fees Rs.20/- per student to be collected from the students at the time of admission as well as re-admission also from the financial year 2020-21.

The amount of Rs.20/-(Rupees Twenty) so collected from each student as Social Service fees at the time of admission & re-admission into U.G. and P.G. classes from the academic session 2020-21, from which Rs.8/- only to be retained at the college for Development of NSS activities in a separate account as Social Service fees head and Rs.12/- is to be deposited in NSS funds of the NSS Bureaus of the Universities/CHSE. The colleges having no NSS unit will remit the entire collection amount to the concerned NSS Bureaus or they can start self financing NSS units and work on NSS with intimation to this department.

enhancement of Social Service fees.

Sir/Madam,

In inviting a reference to the above subject, I am directed to say that as per the decision
taken in NSS State Advisory Committee Meeting held on 05.11.2019, Government have been
pleased to enhance the existing social service fees collected from the students at the time of
admission from Rs.10 per student to Rs 20/ per student, from the financial year 2020-21.

Further it was decided that the amount of Rs.20/- (Rupees Twenty) so collected from each
student as Social Service fees at the time of admission into +3 & PG classes from the academic
session 2020-21, from which Rs.8/- only to be retained at the college for Development of NSS
activities in a separate account as Social Service fees head and Rs. 12/- is to be deposited in NSS
funds of the NSS Bureaus of the Universities/ CHSE. The colleges having no NSS unit will remit
entire collection amount to the concerned NSS Bureaus or they can start self financing NSS units.

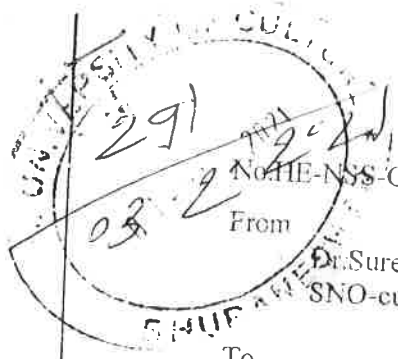

the programme coordinators, Government of India has prescribed for part time Programme Coordinator of NSS for all the NSS Bureaus. But the selection of the programme coordinators should be through proper guideline prescribed in the NSS manual.

It was decided to do it promptly.

10. Tenure of Programme Officers:

The Programme Officers who has completed 6 years may be changed as per the notification no. 18679 dated 19.07.2017 of the State Government.

Hon'ble Minister, Higher Education agreed upon it and suggested that in case of extraordinary work some Programme Officers can be retained for another one year.

11. Purchase of Articles or Equipments at Bureau Level:

The costly articles or equipments like video camera, AC etc. to be purchased at NSS Bureau level, require prior permission from the State Government.

12. Collection of Social Service Fees:

Social Service Fees @Rs.10/- which has been collected for last few years during the time of Admission as well as re-admission may be hiked to Rs. 20/- per volunteer. The Social Service Fees collected from the students is to be deposited in a separate account of the college and NSS Bureaus. The social service fees will also be collected at the time of re-admission also.

The Commissioner- cum- Secretary, Higher Education Department was advised by the Hon'ble Minister to issue letter to the Principals keep co- ordination between the Principals and the Programme Co- ordinators in collection and submission of the Social Service Fees.

13. Incentives and Awards:

To encourage and recognize the social service activities of NSS volunteers the incentives and awards may be initiated at college level and Bureau level. The best programme officers may be given some weightage at the time of selection of principals or their career advancement. NSS orientation and refresher courses should be treated equal to other orientation and refresher courses of UGC academic staff colleges, for career advancement.

14. Release of State Share for Strengthening NSS:

Prior to 2016-17 Govt. of Odisha was releasing State Share in the ratio of 7:5 (Central share: State share) for implementation of NSS activities. For this purpose State Govt. was releasing to the tune of Rs.3 crores every year. From the year 2016-17, release of state share has been stopped due to release of 100 percent financial assistance from Government of India. The State Share to the tune of Rs.3 crores or Rs. 10,000 per college may be approved for strengthening NSS activities in the State to organize more programmes. Rs. 4 lacks provision has been made this year for state award for the volunteers and programme officers.

The Hon'ble Minister advised the Commissioner- cum- Secretary and the SNO to reflect the same in the Supplementary Budget of this year. It was decided to reflect the same in the upcoming budget.
